Albert Burney, of Kimball Twp., formerly of Barbeau, Michigan, passed away peacefully in his sleep on February 12, 2019, just two months short of his 93rd birthday.

Al was born in Los Angeles and raised in Julian, California.

He served in the United State Navy during the Korean War, returning to California after his tour of duty and earned a bachelor's degree in journalism. Al worked for the United States Government his entire career including the United States Postal Service, the United States Forest Service, United States Border Patrol and finally with distinction for the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service.

Al married Jacqueline Tang in 1954 and raised a family living along the southern and northern borders of the United States. Al finished his career in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan retiring in 1981 after 30 years of service.
