



## Mr. Allan J. Eisenhower

July 8, 1917 - September 15, 2014

Allan J. Eisenhower, age 97, of Port Huron, passed away on September 15, 2014 in St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, with his family by his side. He was born on July 8, 1917, in Port Huron, to the late John and Catherine Eisenhower.

Allan served in the U.S. Army Air Force. He was a 1st Lieutenant fighter pilot with the 493rd fighter squadron, in World War II.

He is survived by his wife, Rita, children; Allan Eisenhower, Rita Swanson, Jane Eisenhower, Mary Stevens, Nancy (Rob) Budgell, Carol Bowman, John Eisenhower and Paul Eisenhower, several grandchildren and great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Margaret Eisenhower.

Services will be held on Friday, September 19, 2014 at 12:30 pm at the Allied Veterans Columbarium. Veterans Honor Guard Alliance will provide military honors.
