



## Alvin "Tim" Hinkley

September 22, 1936 - May 17, 2019

The Lord called Alvin "Tim" Hinkley, 82, of Clyde Twp., home on May 17, 2019 in Port Huron, surrounded by his family.

He was born in Port Huron to the late Alvin and Ruth (Radford) Hinkley on September 22, 1936. He attended Port Huron area schools and Owosso Bible College.
