order a #2 and think of a good time you had with Brad and let the waitress know it is honor of Brad.

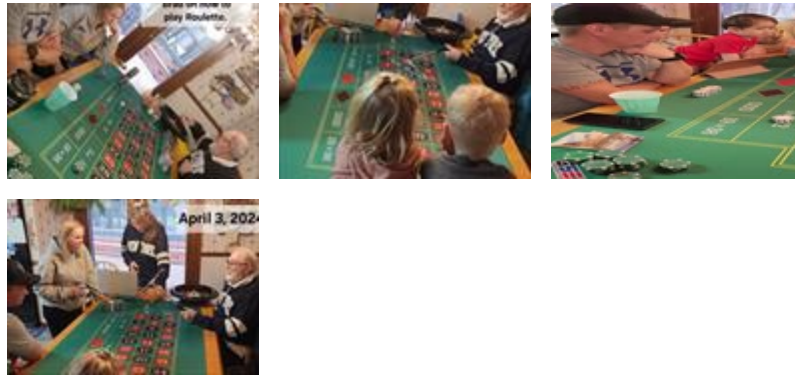

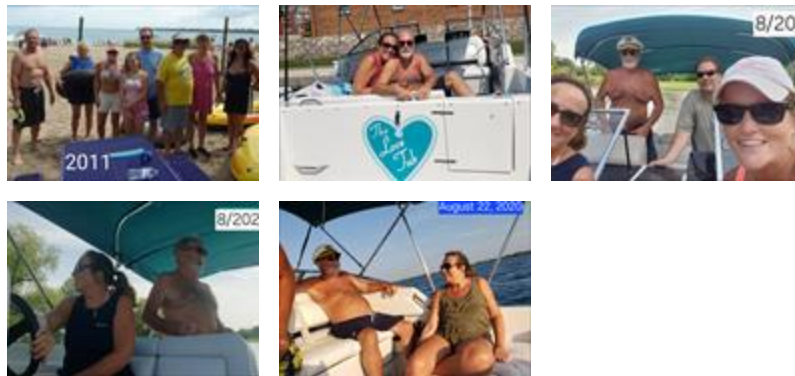
