In lieu of flowers, memorial tributes can be made to the wishes of the family.

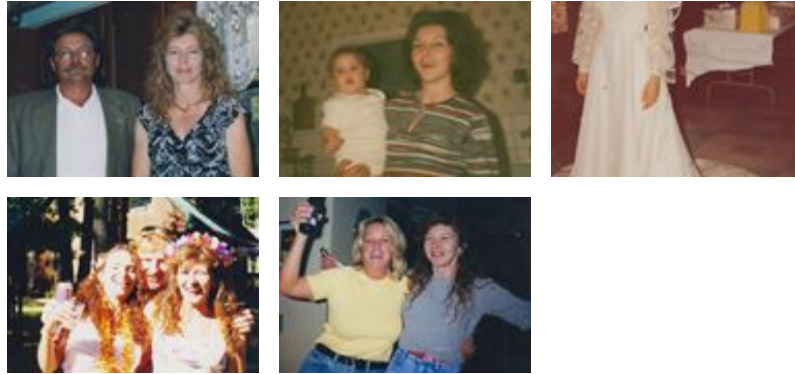
