



## Cynthia Lee Fisher (Lawrence)

September 9, 1958 - February 15, 2023

Cynthia Lee Fisher, age 64, of Milwaukee, passed away peacefully surrounded by family after a long battle with cancer on February 15, 2023.

She was born September 9, 1958 to Claude S. and Alexa (McManus) Lawrence in Pontiac, Michigan. Cindy graduated from Port Huron Central High School in 1976 after which she attended Michigan State University, where she graduated in 1981. Cindy began working for her family's business, By-Lo Oil Company, as an Operations Manager at Speedy-Q gas stations while attending Oakland University in the evenings, receiving her MBA in 1985. After the birth of her three children, Cindy became a stay-at-home mom, serving as the Parent Teacher Association treasurer and a Junior Achievement Mentor at her children's school. In 2006, Cindy and her family moved to Brighton, MI where she was an active volunteer within the community, working at Gleaner's Food Bank of Livingston County for over 10 years. It was during this time that Cindy found a passion for horseback riding. After moving to Milwaukee, WI she began volunteering at Bobbe's Gift Shop at Froedtert Hospital. Cindy was an avid reader, along with being a whiz at games and puzzles. She rarely missed a Jeopardy question, unless the category was 'Opera'. Cindy loved to travel, especially with her daughters and sister, Christine. Some of her favorite trips were to Italy, Paris, the Orkney Islands, Sedona, and Cannon Beach. Above all else, her greatest joy in life was her daughters, whom she fiercely loved.

Cindy was preceded in death by her parents, Claude S. and Alexa Lawrence, her brother Claude B. Lawrence, and two grandchildren, Hudson and Lynnlee Hamilton.
