“ To the courts

As Easter passes I couldn't help but reflect on a year without my sister's hugs, without her voice, and without her laugh. Her death effected every aspect of my life including my daily routine. I stood outside her house a year ago and couldn't help but think about the pain and suffering she endured. How helpless she must of felt. And what great betrayal she must of felt when she was being murdered by Dustin Tucker. The god father of her child. And even when he laid over her dead body he felt no remorse and set her body on fire. He made a choice to destroy her and everything she had including setting fire to her home. I lived with my sister prior to her murder and after her death I thanked the public for their kind gestures, kind words, flowers and financial blessings. I have since moved on with therapy provided by Community Mental Health. And after moving on I couldn't help but notice the constant void that has filled my life with the absence of Danielle Grace Smith. She was my younger sister and closest friend. We shared rooms growing up, beds, make up, clothes, and just really enjoyed sharing not only our stuff together but the world together. Our mutual friends met me with a warm embrace as I continued to emotionally process that a grown man has murdered my youngest sister and appeared to believe he could possibly get away with this act. It's been almost a year since that Saturday. Since her death my medical team has increased my medicine, my coping skills, and has changed my diet to prepare and block any further depression they would trigger my lifetime mental health diagnosis. I have learned to fill the void with memories, new friends, and new hobbies including water aerobics at the local YMCA. I believe my sister was never capable of committing such an act of murder and that this man has went above and beyond, without insurance, without financial gain, to destroy my sister knowing he could not replace her or the impact she had on others. And as we begin to celebrate Easter, I couldn't help but notice a year has passed and I still have many more years to endure. As I continue to protect myself emotionally I find comfort in the law, the judicial system, and the jury. We Americans must put people like

this away for life because it's protects the very principle of our democracy and our rights as a citizen of this great Nation. God bless our current leader Joe Biden. -Sarah Smith

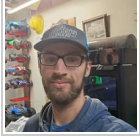
Dear Karen
