*Then in the 1960's my first car was my grandma's 1955 Mercury. We were parked some where and Dave had his feet on the dashboard of my car (I dont remember if it was MY car at that time, or I had just borrowed it from my grandma) but Dave stretched!! the accidentally pushed out the wind shield of the mercury! I was in shock but Dave told me to drive to a field, where he found a huge rock the threw it threw the wind shield & tell my grandma that we had found it like this when we returned to the car. I never would have thought of anything like this.*

*He was always making silly promises that he never kept and I never really expected him to. He was always helping me out when I got into financial trouble. He'd loan me money a few times when I was sick & couldn't not afford to get my script filled. I could count on him when I really needed a friend.*

*There for a while I was packing him lunches when he worked at Chrysler. I'd tuck little notes in there.*

*I think of Dave every day as I am driving the blue jeep patriot he*

*sold to me in 2011.*
