Her wishes were to be remembered with a memorial luncheon, hosted by her family, she wanted a Celebration of Her Life and she will be missed by

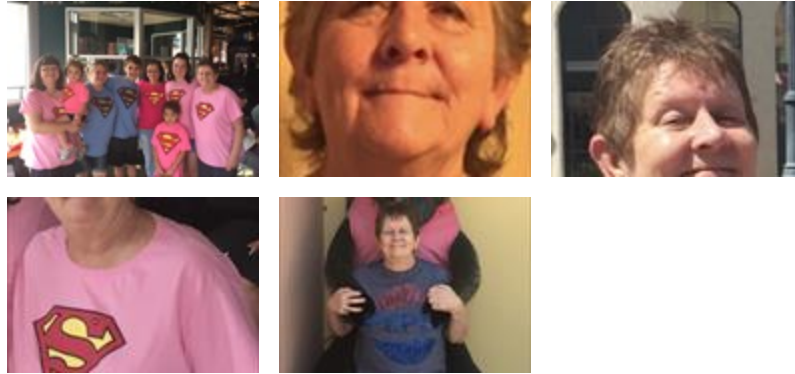
