



## Mr. Dennis Dale "Denny" Brown

May 31, 1951 - December 27, 2014

Dennis Dale "Denny" Brown, age 63, of Almont, passed away on December 27, 2014, in McLaren Hospital, Lapeer, unexpectedly. He was born on May 31, 1951, in Detroit, to the late Floyd and June Brown. He married Sharon Lynn Talos on November 10, 1973, in Mt. Clemens.

Denny graduated from New Haven High School, where he excelled in track and baseball. His love of music was lifelong and started playing the guitar at the age of seven, and never put it down. He especially enjoyed making music with his brother and grandsons. Dennis loved God with all his heart. He was an Elder in his church, was a planner, was on the social committee and was a founding member of the New Haven Seventh Day Adventist Church. He was also a community service leader and enjoyed helping others. He was president of the Almont Chamber of Commerce, from 2009 thru 2012. He was very active with several networking groups, including BNI. You could not get through a conversation with Dennis without talking about Shaklee or the Civil War. He retired from Chrysler, after 35 years, 1972 – 2007 at the Warren Truck Assembly Plant. He loved his yard and his gazebo, playing catch with his grandsons, hosting social events, such as, Barbeques, volleyball and fireworks. He was part of the breakfast group at Maria's in Almont and enjoyed spending time with his friends there. He loved and was loved, by his many nieces and nephews, and even adopted some.


