Esther Weckesser, 90, of Port Huron died Tuesday, October 3 after a short illness.

Mrs. Weckesser was born in Mount Clemens to William and Clara Schmidt on May 31, 1927. She graduated from Mount Clemens High School and went on to earn her bachelor's degree from Capital University in Columbus, OH and her masters from the University of Pittsburgh. She went on to a successful retail buyer's career in Detroit, Grand Rapids, and New York. A stay-at-home mother as her sons were growing up, she went on to succeed as Office Manager for her husband's medical practice.

She married Wallace Weckesser in Detroit on June 8, 1957, as he continued his Medical School training. They came to Port Huron in 1962, where Dr. Weckesser established and maintained his Dermatology practice until his retirement in 1990. Dr. Weckesser passed away on May 27, 2003.
