Gary R. Foster, age 78, went home to be with the Lord on Resurrection Sunday, April 16, 2017, at Medilodge Fort Gratiot, after a long, courageous battle with Parkinson's Disease. He was born in Port Huron on April 1, 1939, to the late Russell and Dorothy Foster. Gary graduated from Port Huron High School in 1957 and married Sarah Jane Ziegler on August 27, 1960, after graduating from Grand Rapids School of the Bible and Music. He was a long-time member of the Ross Bible Church.

They served the Lord in Ontario and Nova Scotia, Canada and then Gary pastored Alton Bible Church, Community Baptist Church, Grace Baptist Church, Payson Bible Church and Columbus Bible Church before retiring in 1989 because of his health.
