Glen J. Doan, age 60, of Fort Gratiot Township, passed away on June 7, 2012 in Port Huron Hospital, with his family by his side, after a long battle with cancer. Glen was born on December 22, 1951 in Port Huron. He married Michelle Devereaux on October 6, 1972 in Port Huron.

Glen retired from the St. Clair County Sheriff Department after 25 years of service, as a corrections officer. He worked for the Burtchville Fire Department from 1983 – 1986. Glen had 25 years of service with the Fort Gratiot Fire Department. He was a fire inspector and Past President of the Firefighters Association. He recently received his certificate in Arson & Fire Investigation. He is survived by his wife, Michelle of Fort Gratiot, sons; Andrew, Matthew and Thomas, 3 grandchildren; Savannah, Ashley and Derek, a granddaughter to be born this fall, parents; James & Donna Doan of Fort Gratiot, sister and brother-in-law; Gail & Tom Wilkins of Port Huron, sister-in-law and brother-in-law; Lee & Shawn Smith of Fort Gratiot, along with several nieces, nephews and special friends.

Glen is preceded in death by grandparents; Mr. & Mrs. G. Doan and Mr. & Mrs. A. Ledsworth, mother-in-law and father-in-law; Mardella & Robert Devereaux.
