Jerrie W. Savin, 74, of Chesterfield, passed away Friday, June 11, 2021. He was diagnosed with colon cancer in 2019 and passed away as a result of complications from Covid-19. Jerrie was a long standing civil servant, whose career spanned more than thirty years. He was a retired member of the Detroit Police Department. Afterwards, he became the Site Supervisor for Akal Security in Detroit's Federal Court System and a Medical Examiner Investigator for Macomb County.
