Jodi Lynn (Haughton) Rempala was a loving wife, mother, aunt, teacher, sister, and friend. She left this world suddenly on April 11, 2023 at age 46. She loved Harry Potter, cats, her family, musicals, baseball games, lighthouse hunting throughout the state, and traveling, and had always put everybody else before herself.

Jodi was born on October 18, 1976 to Rose Ann Haughton and Howard Keith Hundley in Monett, Missouri. She was the oldest of 3 children and raised in mid-Michigan. When Jodi was 7, her mother Rose remarried Michael Haughton, her step-dad, who officially adopted her in 1987. Together they had her two siblings, Amanda and Nicholas.

Jodi's family moved around the state a lot, mostly living in Lansing, Mount Pleasant, Bath, and other cities in mid-Michigan, so she didn't have one high school she stayed at. However, she graduated from Laingsburg High School in 1994 and proceeded to go to Central Michigan University for college, where she received her bachelor's in journalism in 1998.

She also met her husband, Paul Jr., in 1998, whom she married on September 22, 2001. Together, she and Paul had two daughters, Rachel and Melissa.

Jodi worked for the Dearborn Press & Guide for most of her journalism career,

until she moved to Port Huron in 2017 and began working for The Keel. She worked for The Keel up until 2021, when she decided she no longer wanted to take the journalism route and began teaching elementary students at Landmark Academy. She loved her students and school family very much.

Jodi is survived by her husband of 21 years, Paul, her daughters Rachel and Melissa, her mother Rose (Michael), her birth father Keith (Tina), her siblings Amanda (Brian) and Nicholas, her nieces and nephews, and her brothers and sisters-in-law.
