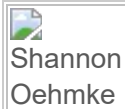
She is preceded in death by her father, Ronald Hochberg and a brother, Ronnie Hochberg.

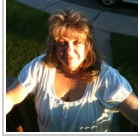

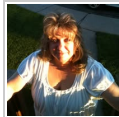
