Kathryn M. Weng, age 82 of Goodells, passed away on May 26, 2025 in the comfort of her home, surrounded by her loving family and friends. She was born on September 21, 1942 in Detroit to the late Thomas and Margaret Grula. She married Herman H. Weng on August 15, 1964 in Detroit. He preceded her in death on May 13, 2025.

From a young age, she faced relentless health struggles, but her resilience, deep compassion, and unshakable sense of independence shaped a life full of love and grace.

Stricken with polio as a child, she lived with the physical effects of post-polio syndrome for the rest of her life, yet never allowed it to define her or diminish her spirit.

Having returned

to school mid-career to earn her master's in education, she dedicated the entire span of

her time in the classroom and library in the Detroit Public Schools. Her strength, intellect,

and quiet defiance of injustice left a lasting impact on generations of students.

Beyond the

classroom, her home was a haven—always open to family, friends, and anyone in need of

support, a meal, or simply a place to feel safe. With a heart that forgave freely and loved deeply, she turned personal hardship into a lifetime of giving, teaching, encouraging, and quietly questioning and challenging the world to be better. She enjoyed reading, shopping and loved to provide meals for loved ones.

Kathi is survived by her sons; Matthew Weng and Timothy Weng, daughter-in-law, Rena Weng, six grandchildren; Dani Weng, Laurel Weng, Alexander Weng, Roswell Weng, Isabella Weng and Nicholas Weng, a nephew, Steven Divozzo and a niece, Jeanne Blankenship.

She was preceded in death by a sister, Joanne Pisa.
