Kenneth Monroe, 81, of Sandusky, Michigan, originally from Caro, Michigan, passed away on May 31, 2026. He was born on April 26, 1945, and spent more than seven decades building a life and a legacy in the community he called home.

Ken served his country as a paratrooper in the United States Army, a chapter of his life that shaped the quiet discipline he carried with him always. After his service, he returned to Michigan and put that same determination to work, building and operating assisted living facilities in the region for over 35 years — caring for others in a way that defined much of his adult life.

Outside of his work, Ken was a man of distinct passions. He was a longtime member of The Country Four, a country western band that brought him joy and brought others together. He was a serious horseman who competed as an avid horse showman, earning the respect of those who knew the dedication that life requires. He had a deep love for sports cars and motorcycles, and those who knew him well knew that a fine machine could bring out a side of Ken that few other things could.

Ken was a reserved man by nature, but those closest to him knew that in his later years he opened up, and what they found was warmth, humor, and a depth of character that had always been there.
