“ From Vikkie J.- Port Huron - I met Kim in the summer of 2007. We would sit on the banks of the St. Clair River, drink pop, munch cookies, make pinkie promises and talk. When a freighter came up or down the river she would tell me about the flag it flew, how long the freighter was, the cargo it carried... She recognized many freighters by the sound of their engines. She told me about a night many years ago, when she told her dad about a freighter coming down river before he heard it. She named it, said it was about 2 miles out and told him approximately how many minutes before it would come into sight. For a while he still didn't hear it. She was delighted when it came by just as she had said, and at a speed that rattled the windows of their house. In the fall of 2014, some of my family came to Michigan for my son's memorial. Kim was commissioned as a photographer and tour guide for an afternoon of respite. We ate at The Raven in downtown Port Huron, went to Vantage Point, and then to Lighthouse beach in Fort Gratiot. As dusk approached we went to the Blue Water Bridge, lit up with blue lights. Kim pointed out the markers, and buoys and explained as we watched a freighter cut back speed, navigating the turn, avoiding possible mishap in the swift main channel. We shared much these last 8 years. . Kim was an amazing woman. She held two college degrees, she was a musician, artist, an avid reader .. a survivor and an overcomer, and so much more. Most importantly, she was a Christian friend. I am a better woman for having known her. Kim sent to me words of comfort in my grief. I find that comfort . Her words are re gifted to me now, as I grieve my loss of her also. I'd like to share two texts: March 16, 2015,, 1139a Let the spirit of (my son's name) live on in your actions.-kimber August 31, 2015 3:50p I'm saying a prayer to guide you from one point to the next. It may not be exactly what you want, but it will cover the bases. -kimber
