She moved back to Texas in 1977.

She also attended Community Enterprise after we moved from Texas in 2011 to Port Huron, Michigan. Recently she was awarded most improved consumer in her Life Skills class. It appears she excelled from then on.

March of 2011 she and another young lady, Carolyn Maxwell (she became Kristy's sister) shared an apartment with Blue Water Housing Developing supporting us with staff. God sent us the best staff ever under the direction of Delaney Rogan, who was Kristy's 2nd mother. Being a mother, it's hard to let the care of your impaired child to someone else.

Kristy attended Colonial Woods Missionary Church and made many new

friends there. She is survived by her brother in Arlington, Texas, David Ayers (Marsi) who was Kristy's idol, sister, AmyJo Ayers, brother, Leroy Ayers, niece, Jordan, nephews, Jonathon (Alex), Joey, Jarred and Jacob, aunts, uncles, niece and nephews in Texas, aunt and uncle in Port Huron, Reverend Paul and Claudia Smith, Kristy called for them during this time. Also, cousins and family in New Castle, Pennsylvania.

February 2017, Kristy was diagnosed with Stage 4 Cancer and they gave her 6 months. God said no. Blue Water Hospice came in Fall of 2017 and visited Kristy during this time. The miracle is Kristy had no pain in all those years she was covered with cancer. Kristy's Lord is good.
