Lucienne M. "Lu" Kiefer, age 77 of Port Huron, passed away on April 13, 2026, unexpectedly. She was born on July 25, 1948 in Port Huron to the late Frederick and Colette Pettee. She married Daniel M. Kiefer on March 21, 1970 in Port Huron. Dan preceded her in death on July 27, 2013.

Lucienne earned her master's degree from Western Michigan University. She retired as an English teacher from the Marysville Public Schools, having served from 1971 until 2006. Although Lucienne and Dan did not have children, she regarded each of her students as her own.

Lucienne previously served as president of the Port Huron Business and Professional Women and was currently affiliated with the Port Huron Museum, and the Port Huron Council on Aging. She held the position of secretary and later corresponding secretary for the Blue Water Art Association and was also a member of the St. Clair Art Association. Additionally, she participated in various social and recreational groups, including the Tally Ho Wednesday night Euchre, Monday night Mahjong group and the Fun Club, a group of ladies monthly get together. Lu was loved by many friends and will be dearly missed.

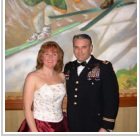
