He was preceded in death by his son, Michael Whitchsett, and brothers; JW Whitsett, Terry Whitsett and Frank Whitsett.

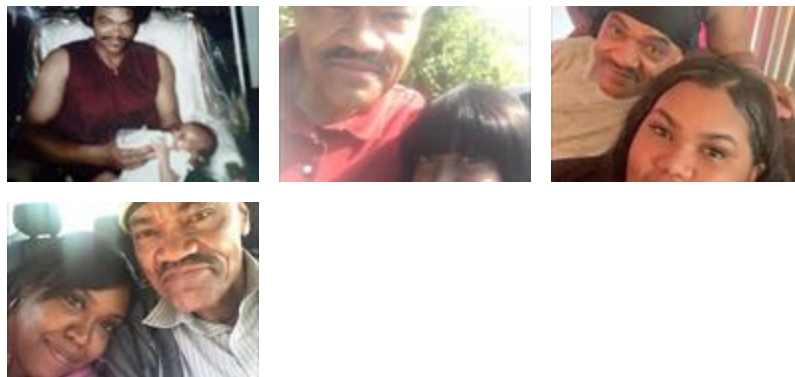
