March 13, 1931 - July 6, 2022

Muriel E. Moore, age 91, of Clinton Twp., passed away on July 6, 2022. She was born on March 13, 1931, in Detroit. She married Bill "Chuck" Moore, he preceded her in death on May 19, 2022.

Like her husband of 73 years, Muriel mirrored Bill's faith and strength of character. Managing the church bookstore, serving meals for the Kiwanis Club, sewing pillow dresses for the children of Malawi, making quilts for missions, the list goes on! She even found time to volunteer as an usher at the Fox Theatre with her best friend, Marcia Bird. She felt strongly that everyone needs to be recognized and was flawless to deliver her "Hallmark" greetings at birthday and anniversary times with a card to mark the event. Even with all the generosity

she showed, it could be said that she was relentless in her pursuit of the \$5 refund from any retailer that was found to have overcharged due to a scanning error. She may in fact hold the world's record!
