I, Paul C. Pearson, was called Heavenward by Christ Jesus on November 6, 2017, at age of 70. I was born in Flint, Michigan on August 26, 1947 to Vernon E. and Jean A. (Lowell) Pearson. We moved to Port Huron, Michigan in 1954. I graduated from Port Huron High School in 1965, and entered the United States Air Force after graduation. 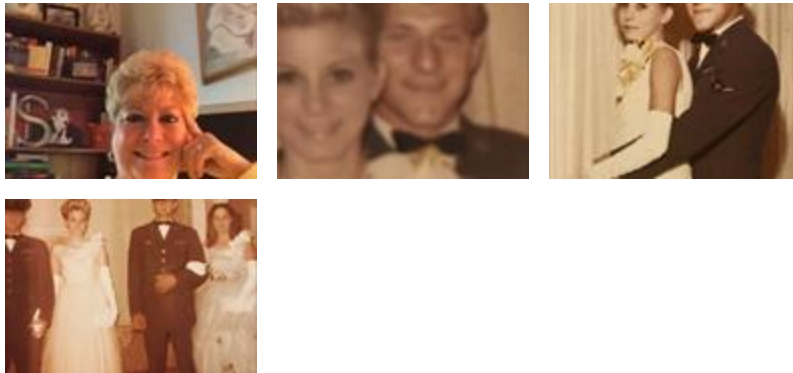
