



## Rev. Robert E. Riedel

June 12, 1928 - December 8, 2021

Rev. Robert Earl Riedel, age 93, of Port Huron passed away peacefully on December 8, 2021 at Regency on the Lake, where he was residing after having a stroke.

He was born in Wheeling, West Virginia on June 12, 1928 to the late Alfred and Clara (Fischer) Riedel. After graduating Union High School in McMechen, West Virginia, he went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree at Capital University in Columbus, Ohio. He then began his studies at Trinity Lutheran Seminary. 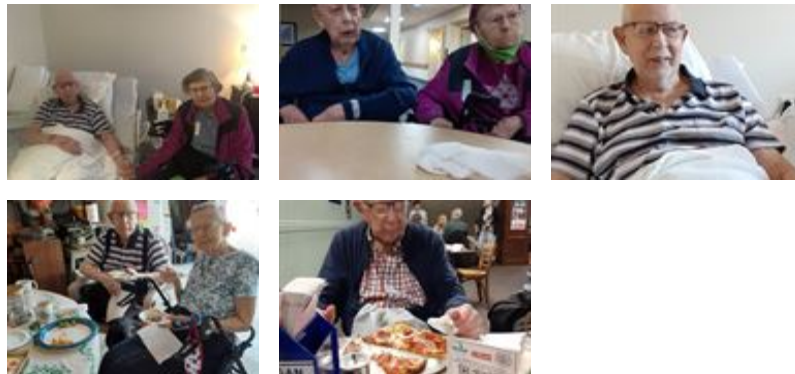
