Robert Thomas Wall, 92, of Algonac died Monday, June 21, 2021 at home. He had asked that no one cry or be sad after his passing, that he lived a long and happy life for which he was grateful.

Bob grew up on Ward Avenue in Detroit and attended Mackenzie High School.

He was a proud graduate of Wayne State University and the University of Michigan Law School in 1953. He went on to practice law in Warren and Marine City, and he still represented clients at hearings through the COVID-19 pandemic using Zoom.

Earlier, he served in the U.S. Army in the Corps of Engineers and was stationed in France.

Born in Detroit on January 3, 1929, he spent summers in Fair Haven.

Bob sailed throughout North America, including racing his Hobie Cat and his Tartan 34C "Chippewa" in the Port Huron to Mackinac series with his wife, Pamela. Over 27 years, they celebrated 25 flags including eight 1st Place wins.

He is predeceased by his parents and two sisters. He is survived by his wife Pamela and his children Phoebe, Genevieve and Rob., his son-in-law John and a grandchild, Eli. He will also be missed by his cats Duke and Clara and his dog Bentley.

Pam and Bob would have celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary in July. They are longtime members of the Port Huron Yacht Club, where he was

known as Sir Robert since his wife's commodore tenure.

A celebration of life will be 12:00pm Saturday, July 17, 2021, at the Port Huron Yacht Club, 212 Quay Street, Port Huron.

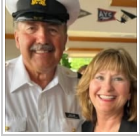
