Sabina E. Murray, 95, of Yale, passed away Thursday, December 11, 2014, from this earth to begin an eternity of Joy with God. She was born on July 9, 1919, in Detroit, and an area resident since 1936.

She is survived by two daughters; Loretta (Walter) Edwards of Yale and Geraldine (Rev. As a Past President of the Patriarchs Militant Auxiliary to Canton Huron 15, she also served as Sentry for the Department Association of Michigan. She was assistant advisor of Blue Moon Theta Rho Club 25 for two years. She is a charter member and the first Past Matriarch of the Ladies Encampment Auxiliary 158 and belonged to the Golden Agers. She was past Vice Oracle of the Royal Neighbors of America. She formerly belonged to the Eastern Stars, Chapter 58.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Clarence Murray and daughter, Charlotte.
