



Sam was loved very much by many people. He will be missed.

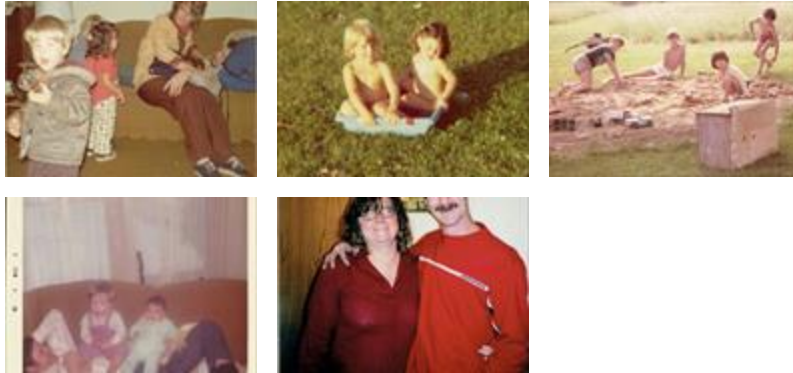
