Scott (Scooter) Robert McLaughlin passed away unexpectedly at the age of 63. Scott was born on February 20, 1959 in Port Huron, Michigan, the son of the late Robert and Janice McLaughlin.

Scott was a 1978 graduate of Port Huron Central High School. Scott was a construction journeyman and strong union supporter. He joined the Laborers' International Union of North America (LIUNA) and Local 463 in Port Huron in 1979. He also worked out of Local 563 in Minnesota. He returned home to Port Huron and transferred to Local 334 in Detroit, Michigan. He served on the executive board and was very active as a member and steward on many large projects. He was known for his construction skills and as a leader in his field. He retired in 2008.

Scott was a Harley Davidson motorcycle enthusiast, belonging to the Legion Riders of Post 4 in Mt. Clemens, Michigan. He enjoyed many motorcycle runs, rallies, and fundraising events associated with Post 4 and Post 8 of Marysville, Michigan. 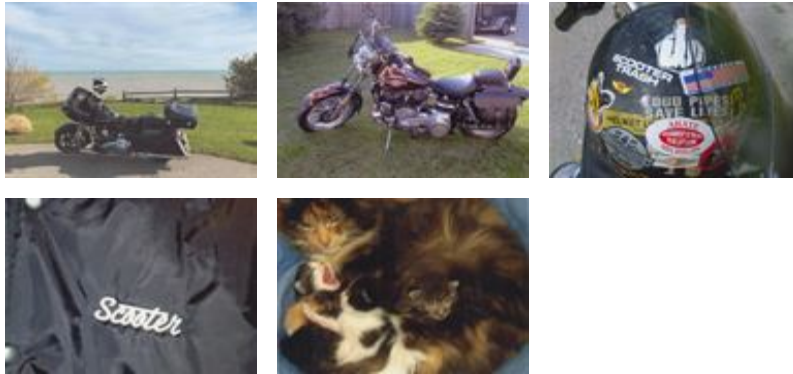
