Sharon K. Cameron, age 81, of Port Huron Township went home to join the Lord in heaven on January 24, 2022.

She was born on August 21, 1940 in Port Huron to the late Arthur And Victoria Allen. Sharon loved Donald C. Cameron and they were married on May 27, 1961. He preceded her in death on September 8, 2010.

Sharon attended Port Huron High school and played the trombone in the Big Red Marching Machine. After she graduated, she remained a lifelong fan and was the Big Reds' greatest supporter. Rain, snow, wind, or shine, she braved the weather and attended football, baseball, softball, basketball, and volleyball games to not only champion her children and grandchildren during their games, but to also proudly sport her Big Red gear and cheer on her alma mater.

After high school, Sharon worked at Mueller Brass for 5 years until she left the company to care for her four children. She raised them in a loving home and was an integral presence in their lives. Sharon also touched the lives of countless others; she was a loyal volunteer at Port Huron (McLaren) Hospital for 30+ years, a member of the Chapter 10 Women's Life Gamma Nu club for 39 years, and a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles #3702 . Through these organizations, she developed lifelong friendships and participated in community outreach events that allowed her to offer her kindness to others and share her inspiring, giving personality, as well as her crocheting, sewing, and baking skills, with the Port Huron community. Sharon loved animals, and

had a profound impact on the lives of several rescue dogs and cats that she took into her loving home throughout the years.

Sharon loved spending time with her family. Outside of attending birthday parties, holidays, school and sporting events for her children and grandchildren, one of her favorite things to do with her family was participate in Cruise Nights and car shows in the Blue Water area. She loved driving and riding in Don's '68 Charger and '34 Ford hotrod up and down the streets strewn with classic cars, and being surrounded by her children and grandchildren at car shows.

Sharon had a beautiful soul. She extended kindness and grace to everyone, whether she knew them and loved them dearly or had just met them. She was slow to anger, quick to forgive, and always acted with class. Her gentle spirit was accompanied by an iron will and amazing strength. She was incredibly tough and selfless, always supporting others and asking for nothing for herself. She was a wife, a mother, and a grandmother, but she was also so much more; she was a very dear friend to her husband, her children, and her grandchildren. She acted with tremendous love for her family and friends every day, and she was and still is dearly loved by them. They feel incredibly blessed to have known her so well, and are delighted and filled with joy to know that she and her love, Don, are now dancing together on angel's wings in the presence of the Lord.

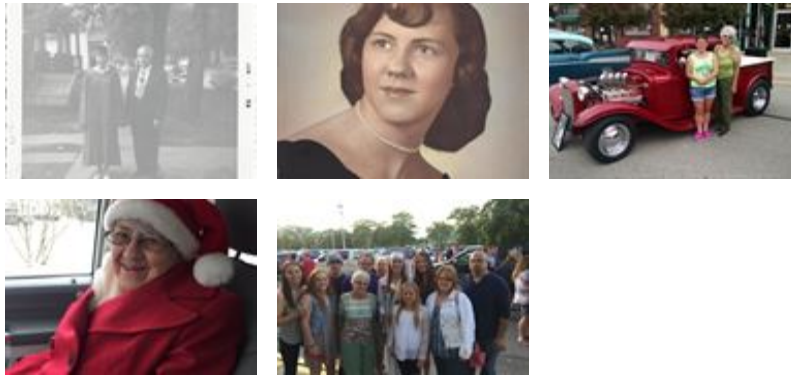
