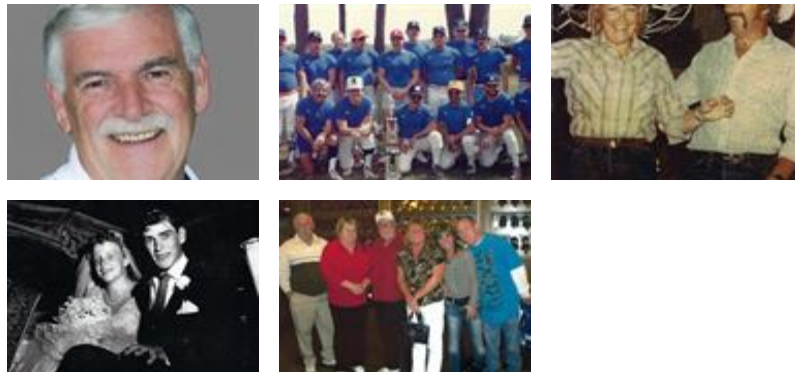
“ Dear Tom, Tammy and Pam,
