Verna A. (Lumree) Carrier, age 100, of Port Huron Township, passed away on May 20, 2022. She was born on December 17, 1921 in Port Huron to O. Roy “Bud” and Edith (Gordon) Lumree. On April 7, 1941, Verna married Raymond E. Carrier in Port Clinton, OH.

Up until five months ago, Verna had been a resident of Dorchester Apartments for the previous ten years. She had made many new friends and enjoyed her surroundings. Always able to look out of her window at nighttime, being able to see the light atop the antenna at the T.V. Cable Co., only a few doors from her home of 30 plus years on Alger Rd., shared with her husband, Raymond of 62 years of marriage.

As was the common practice in Verna’s days as a young person, she moved many times, especially following the death of her mother. Verna was nine years old at the time. She and her sister, Donna lived with different aunts and uncles until her dad married Catherine Frye. Verna attended Jefferson, Washington, and Polk Schools. Mom was stay-at-home mom until she took up the career as a mailroom diva at the Times Herald in 1968, making many friends by the time she retired in 2005, consisting of 35 years of service at the age of 83 years young. Those were enjoyable years for mother. Work a few hours, take a lunch with her friends at work, especially at different locations. Either, in Port Huron or downriver and then back to work when the presses were again ready to run. Needless to say, she totally enjoyed her times assisting with putting on special lunches and celebration parties along with her

co-workers.

Family was always her most important interest though. She gave out so much interesting history of family, dates, and memories. “Just imagine visiting relatives in the old days, in Waterford, MI. Having to add water to the radiator or change a tire or two along the way, and in the cold weather, trying to keep the side curtains tight enough to keep the cold from becoming unbearable at times.” She was always ready to be with the family or to go wherever they wanted to take her.

Verna has left five children behind to mourn her passing. Sons; Raymond C. (Martha) Carrier of Clyde, Dennis R. Carrier of Farwell, MI., William P. (Diana) Carrier of Marysville, Richard B. (Marsha) Carrier of Port Huron, and daughter, Joann (Lewis) Andrews of Clanton, AL. Brother-in-law; Robert P. Carrier of Fargo, MI. Sixteen grandchildren, thirty-eight great-grandchildren, and thirty-one great-great grandchildren. Along with many many nieces and nephews. Verna is now “Home” where she is reunited with her mom and dad, her husband of 62 years, Ray. 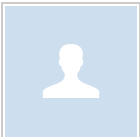

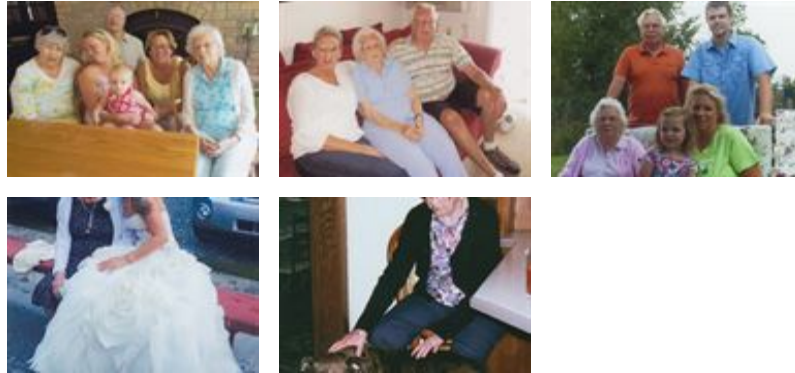
